**Birmingham Zoo to Host Brian Badger with the
Cheetah Conservation Fund**

BIRMINGHAM, AL – The Birmingham Zoo is excited to host Brian Badger with the Cheetah Conservation Fund this Friday, February fifth from 6-8pm in the Zoo Auditorium. Brian Badger's visit to the Birmingham Zoo is part of his United States Tour. While at the Zoo, Badger will present, "The Diversity of Frontline Conservation...It's Not All About Cheetahs!" His presentation will cover the incredibly varied work that the Cheetah Conservation Fund does in Namibia and around the world in the endeavor to save the species. This event is FREE and open to the public.

Approximately 950 animals of 230 species call the Birmingham Zoo home, including sea lions, zebras, rhinos and endangered species from six continents. The Birmingham Zoo is open daily from 9am to 5pm. Regular admission is \$16 for adults and \$14* for senior citizens and military and \$11* for children ages 2-12 (*Price not including tax). All Birmingham Zoo Members and children under two-years-old receive free admission.*
