ZooLight Safari Presented by Wells Fargo Begins this Friday

BIRMINGHAM, AL – ZooLight Safari presented by Wells Fargo, the Birmingham Zoo's annual holiday event, will begin this weekend, December 9-11 from 5-9pm and will continue throughout the month on December 16-23 and 26-31 from 5-9pm. The Presenting Sponsor of this event is Wells Fargo. New this year, guests can take advantage of an all-inclusive ticket that includes event admission and unlimited rides on the Zoo's Candy Cane Train, Jingle Bell Carousel, Yuletide Slide and Santa's Roller Racers. Guests can dance to live music each night, write letters to and take photos with Santa, and stroll through over one million lights as the Zoo is transformed into a winter wonderland. Guests ages 21+ will also have the option to purchase adult beverages at ZooLight Safari including beer, wine and hard eggnog.

Zoo Members receive free admission to each night of ZooLight Safari. Admission for non-members is \$10, individual ride tickets are \$3.50, and unlimited attraction wristbands are \$10. The Zoo will close at 4pm each night of ZooLight Safari. Animals will not be on exhibit during ZooLight Safari. This event is weather permitting.

Approximately 900 animals of 230 species call the Birmingham Zoo home, including sea lions, zebras, rhinos and endangered species from six continents. The Birmingham Zoo is open daily from 9am to 5pm. Regular admission is \$16 for adults and \$14* for senior citizens and military and \$11* for children ages 2-12 (*Price not including tax). All Birmingham Zoo Members and children under two-years-old receive free admission.*
