


At the **zoo**, there are many animals to see and activities to do. When I get to the **zoo**, I will wait in line with my group until it is my turn to go in.

As I go into the **zoo**, I can get a map. I can pick the animals I want to see and follow the **map** to find them.






If I get hungry, I can eat the snack I brought or buy something from **Wild Burger** 







If I need a bathroom break, I will ask my group or family for permission. This way everyone knows where I am and I feel safe.

Some places at the **zoo** will be loud! I can always ask to go to a quiet place with my group or family, like **Alabama Wilds.** 




If I am feeling overwhelmed, I can go to a Quiet Zone. I can find these on the Zoo map or ask a Zoo staff member.



I can also use headphones if the noises are too loud.










I can visit the barn and brush the animals that are close to me. The animals like to be softly brushed on their backs. If I don't want to brush the animals, I can stay with my group and watch.





I will walk on the paths at the **zoo** and stay with my group.



I may need to wait to see an animal and take turns with other visitors. Waiting and taking turns helps keep everyone safe and makes sure everyone has fun.








Sometimes the animals may be sleeping or away from their habitat for a while. I know that I can come back to see them again another time.
