BIRMINGHAM, AL – The Birmingham Zoo is thankful to generous community support for pushing the "Support Your Zoo's Animals" year-end fundraising campaign across the line to surpass its bold goal of raising \$75,000 by December 31, 2022. Donors, Zoo Members, volunteers, and other animal-loving citizens generously contributed more than \$133,000 to provide nutrition and care for the more than 500 animals that call the Zoo "home." Each animal receives an annual exam by the veterinary team; a customized diet that meets its specific nutritional needs and daily wellness checks by animal care professionals. This kind of care would not be possible without the philanthropic support of kind-hearted community members.

Zoo President & CEO Chris Pfefferkorn said, "I'm elated by the generosity of our community. It warms my heart to know that people value their Zoo and are willing to help care for the animals.
